**2. Beware of people who \_\_\_\_\_**

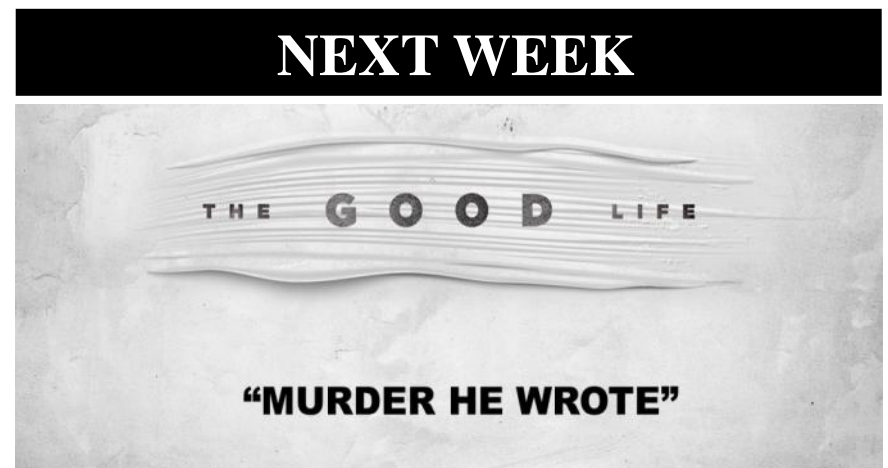
