“¹⁸One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers —Simon, also called Peter, and Andrew— throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living. ¹⁹Jesus called out to them, ‘Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!’ ²⁰And they left their nets at once and followed him. ²¹A little farther up the shore he saw two other brothers, James and John, sitting in a boat with their father, Zebedee, repairing their nets. And he called them to come, too. ²²They immediately followed him, leaving the boat and their father behind.” Matthew 5:18-22

“¹One day as Jesus was preaching on the shore of the Sea of Galilee, great crowds pressed in on him to listen to the word of God. ²He noticed two empty boats at the water’s edge, for the fishermen had left them and were washing their nets. ³Stepping into one of the boats, Jesus asked Simon, its owner, to push it out into the water. So he sat in the boat and taught the crowds from there.” Luke 5:1-3

But if you say so, I’ll let the nets down again.’ ⁶And this time their nets were so full of fish they began to tear! ⁷A shout for help brought their partners in the other boat, and soon both boats were filled with fish and on the verge of sinking. ⁸When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, ‘Oh, Lord, please leave me—I’m too much of a sinner to be around you.’ ⁹For he was awestruck by the number of fish they had caught, as were the others with him.” Luke 5:4-9
